





| 1 |  | Art Brew | Holsworthy, Devon | Chocolate Vanilla Porter | A smooth sweet porter brewed with Chocolate Malt and lactose and then infused with vanilla pods. | 6.0 |  |
| 2 |  | Bedlam | Albourne, Sussex | Porter | Pale, Crystal, Brown and Chocolate malts blended with fresh Fuggles and Goldings hops offer full-on roasted aromas combined with chocolate and coffee flavours. | 5.0 |  |
| 3 |  | Bespoke | Mitcheledean | Round Robin | A copper-hued, generously hopped IPA | 4.8 |  |
| 4 |  | Black Rock | Falmouth, Cornwall | Black IPA | A speciality beer, midnight black and good for the soul. Its complex malt character finishes with surprising crispness, revealing a high-alpha dose of transatlantic hoppiness. | 6.0 |  |
| 5 |  | Blue Monkey | Nottingham | Chimply Red | A crisp bitterness and pine aroma followed by a sweet citrus fruit flavour and a hint of rye malt. | 4.4 |  |
| 6 |  | Blue Monkey | Nottingham | Chocolate Amaretto Guerilla Stout | A complex & malty stout with a rich chocolate aroma & flavours. | 4.9 |  |
| 7 |  | Bowland Brewery | Clitheroe, Lancs | Deer Stalker | Dark, rich stout full of dark fruit flavours with a chocolatey finish obtained from the roasted malts. | 4.5 |  |
| 8 |  | Brewhouse and Kitchen | Cheltenham | Codebreaker | Dark and satisfying like their standard Porter, but brewed with Beechwood Smoked Malt for a real smoky taste that complements the roasted malts | 5.0 |  |
| 9 |  | Brewhouse and Kitchen | Gloucester | Hello Darkness (My old friend) | A Bourbon barrel-aged stout. Smooth and rich with plenty of flavour. | 4.8 |  |
| 10 |  | Brewsmith | Ramsbottom, Bury | Oatmeal Stout | SIBA North West Silver award winner in 2016, this is a full bodied, richly textured stout. Balanced bitterness. Coffee, liquorish, blackcurrant and citrus aromas. | 5.2 |  |
| 11 |  | Brighton Bier | Brighton, Sussex | Grand Havana Smoked Porter | A complex and robust porter brewed with Weyermann beechwood smoked malt. Subtle smokiness combined with layers of satisfying coffee and chocolate flavour. VEGAN | 5.0 |  |
| 12 |  | Bristol Beer Factory | Bristol | TWAF Winter Latte Stout | Specifically brewed for this festival - a milk stout with hints of coffee. | 6.0 |  |
| 13 |  | Castle Brewery | Lostwithiel, Cornwall | Once a night | Lots of wheat, malty flavours with a citrus finish. | 5.0 |  |
| 14 |  | Corinium Ales | Cirencester | 1 AD | Dark smoky porter with mocha notes; great by the fireside...delicious! | 4.4 |  |
| 15 |  | Daleside Brewery | Harrogate, Yorks. | Daleside Porter | Distinctively dark in colour with classic chocolate, coffee and roast flavours. Full bodied with a smooth, dry, velvety finish. | 4.4 |  |
| 16 |  | Dorset Beer Company | Dorchester, Dorset | Frosted Jack | Lovely pale winter ale. | 4.3 |  |
| 17 |  | Downlands | Small Dole, W. Sussex | Old | Our deep red Old is a feast of resinous pine, roasted coffee and burnt caramel flavours | 4.4 |  |
| 18 |  | Dynamite Valley | Ponsanooth, Cornwall | Black Charge | A sweet, oatmeal stout. Smooth, sweet and with a hint of coffee, this will blow up your taste buds. Aroma - toffee, coffee. | 5.0 |  |
| 19 |  | Elusive Brewing | Wokingham, Berks | Spellbinder | Whole bean coffee (Honduras Finca Cerro Azul Natural Red Catuai) was added during cold conditioning to bring a clean coffee flavour and aroma with hints of dark berry fruits. | 6.0 |  |
| 20 |  | Fernandes | Wakefield, Yorks. | Jackdaw Mild | Sweet fruity, toffee aroma. Deep chestnut brown with a cream head. Chocolate, blackcurrant flavours, sweet, fruity, | 5.0 |  |

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| 21 |  | Fine Tuned Brewery | Somerton, Somerset | Silent Night | A chocolate stout. | 4.5 |  |
| 22 |  | Fownes Brewing Co. | Dudley, W. Midlands | Hand of Doom | A big malt backbone which supports a big bitterness and more hops than in any of our other beers. This Double IPA has flavours of grapefruit, orange and lemon with an underlying floral quality. Vegan friendly | 8.2 |  |
| 23 |  | Fownes Brewing Co. | Dudley, W. Midlands | Leviathan | A winter seasonal delight of complex malt flavours balanced with traditional spices to bring you the spirit of Winter in a glass. Barrel aged for 6 months. Vegan friendly. | 7.0 |  |
| 24 |  | Franklins Brewing Co. | Ringmer, Sussex | Benjamin | Named after our Presidential namesake -a chewy, nutty American Brown made with 50kg of lovingly hand peeled chestnuts to accentuate the nutty, toasty feel (contains nuts) | 4.5 |  |
| 25 |  | Froth Blower Brewing Co. | Birmingham | Old Pals Ale | Very much the 'winter warmer': pale and dark malts - with a little addition of hops – combine to produce a sweetish, full-bodied beer | 5.7 |  |
| 26 |  | Glede Brewery | Clevedon, Somerset | Welcome to Winter | An English style bitter with hints of clove and cinnamon for a seasonal feel. | 4.0 |  |
| 27 |  | Gloucester Brewery | Gloucester | Imperial Stout | Rich, smooth & warming, with an aroma of roasted coffee & sultanas. Vegan friendly. | 9.0 |  |
| 28 |  | Goff's Brewery | Winchcombe | Winter Ale | Chocolate malts give a rich, dark look and feel to this beer and the natural blackberry flavouring gives a wonderful fruitiness in the aroma and taste. | 4.5 |  |

| 30 | | Hattie Brown | Swannage, Dorset | Xmas Pale Ale | | 7.3 |  |
| 31 |  | Hillside Brewery | Longhope | Severn Surge | Using 7 different types of malt, this modern-style Porter has a complex roasted character, and a dark berry aroma to finish. | 5.4 |  |
| 32 |  | Keep Brewing | Nailsworth | Hanunga | Using UK experimental hops - a strong traditional ale with a modern UK hop twist. Herbal and Tangerine notes followed by rich malt | 6.0 |  |
| 33 |  | Kelburn Brewery | Glasgow | Unco Hoppy | Kelburn's red, rich and smooth tribute to Rabbe Burns' Tam o' Shanter. A pleasant bitter at 4.4% so you don't get too "fou and unco happy". Triple-hopped using whole cones to give a fruity, floral depth with a citrus finish. | 4.4 |  |
| 34 |  | Kettlesmith Brewing | Bradford on Avon | Stone Angel | Based on recipes for beer before hops were widely used. Includes many home grown herbs organic honey blended with some of the more exotic spices used by Medieval brewers. Light | 5.2 |  |
| 35 |  | Lincolnshire Craft Beers | Barnetby, Lincs. | Winter Woolies | Amber colour with a white head. Aroma - malty, caramel. | 3.6 |  |
| 36 |  | Loud Shirt | Brighton, Sussex | Ecstasy Stout | | 6.6 |  |
| 37 |  | Mad Dog | Pontypool, S. Wales | Frosty Nights | A winter-berry, red ale - made with real winter berries. This beer is unfiltered and therefore may be hazy. Vegan friendly. | 4.5 |  |
| 38 |  | Mauldons | Sudbury, Suffolk | Eatanswill Old | A winter ale of deep red and brown hue. It has a well-balanced fruit and malt flavour plus a slight sweetness on the palate, ending in a pleasant, roast bitterness. | 4.0 |  |
| 39 |  | Maxim Brewing | Houghton-Le-Spring, Durham | Mosaic Pale | The mosaic hops used are named in honour of the assortment of flavours and aromas that this single hop is capable of presenting including, blueberry, tangerine, papaya and bubble | 4.5 |  |
| 40 |  | Moles Brewing (Wickwar) | Melksham, Wilts. | Mole Catcher | A full bodied, dark copper strong ale with a delicate spicy hop aroma and taste coming from the single varietal Cascade hops which also gives it a long bitter finish. | 5.0 |  |

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| 41 |  | Moor Brewery | Bristol | Old Freddy Walker | Champion Winter Beer of Britain 2017. A strong ale, with a rich flavour perfectly balanced between chocolate, honey, dark roasts and a hint of liquorice. | 7.5 |  |
| 42 |  | New Bristol | Bristol | Raven's Wing | A smooth and silky milk stout with British hops Bramling cross and Lactose. A nice winter beer to warm up the cockles. | 7.0 |  |
| 43 |  | Nine Lives Brewing | Powys, S. Wales | Merry Berry | A dark red ale bursting with autumn fruits, spice and rich malt flavours. | 6.9 |  |
| 44 |  | Peerless Brewing | Birkenhead, Merseyside. | Curved Ball Blonde | Curve Ball is lower in strength but well-bittered and chock full of flavour. The finish is zesty with notes of citrus and a floral aroma. Hopped with a blend of 5 American hops. | 3.7 |  |
| 45 |  | Penzance Brewery | Crowlas, Cornwall | Fortytude | Brewed specifically for Camra Kernow to celebrate their 40th anniversary in 2017. A red ale with a biscuit- malt roast and plenty of flavour. | 5.0 |  |
| 46 |  | Penzance Brewery | Crowlas, Cornwall | Scilly Stout | This is warming, velvety, almost jet black, but with a faint autumnal red tinge - a heavyweight of a stout. | 7.0 |  |
| 47 |  | Pershore Brewery | Pershore, Worcs. | Winter Warrior | A special winter ale, heavily hopped to help keep away those winter blues. Chestnut in colour, incorporating Pale, Crystal and Roasted Barley malts. | 5.0 |  |
| 48 |  | Prescott Brewery | Cheltenham | Season's Best - Winter | Specially brewed for the winter months; with just a hint of vanilla, a smooth and deliciously rich Ruby Stout. | 4.2 |  |
| 49 |  | Rat Brewing | Huddersfield, Yorks. | Fat Rat | Rich, robust stout. Rich, black and full bodied stout made with a blend of malts and roasted barley, generously hopped with Simcoe hops for a dry finish and spicy, pinecone aroma. | 6.0 |  |
| 50 |  | Rat Brewing | Huddersfield, Yorks. | Ratsputin | A rich, barrel-aged Russian Imperial Stout. | 7.4 |  |
| 51 |  | Riviera Brewing | Totnes, Devon | Festival Special | A slightly beefier version of their Devonian - Amber Ale easy drinking with Bramling Cross providing a subtle bitterness and Fuggles, Bobek, Cascade Hops providing a fruity floral finish | 4.5 |  |
| 52 |  | Romney Marsh | New Romney, Kent | Cinque Porter | A well-hopped and deliciously dark beer with rich malt flavours. | 4.2 |  |
| 53 |  | Roosters | Knaresborough Yorks. | 25th Anniversary Pale Ale | Limited edition pale ale brewed using two outstanding New World Hops- Rakau from New Zealand and Citra from the USA. Tropical fruits and hints of citrus (notably grapefruit). | 4.3 |  |
| 54 |  | Sarah Hughes | Dudley, W. Midlands | Snowflake | A flavour of candy sugar, plenty of rich malt, slight creamy body and plenty of berry fruits. Rich and warming with a malty finish. | 8.0 |  |
| 55 |  | Settle Brewing Co. | Settle, N. Yorks. | Epic IPA | Crisp and fruity, brewed with American Citra and New Zealand hops to give this refreshing Pale Ale an Epic hop hit. | 4.4 |  |
| 56 |  | Severn Brewing Limited | Wotton-under-Edge | Ruby Porter | Dark and delicious porter with deep- roasted, malt flavours. Balanced with traditional English hops. | 4.8 |  |
| 57 |  | St George's Brewery | Callow End, Worcs. | Golden Dragon | A light golden ale brewed using Slovenia hops for a sweet mellow flavour. | 4.1 |  |
| 58 |  | St Ives Brewery | St Ives, Cornwall | Brewhouse Belgium | Strong Belgian style wheat beer. Cloudy with a zesty tone and dry hopped finish. | 7.3 |  |
| 59 |  | Staggeringly Good | Southsea, Hants. | Post Impact Porter | Roasted malts sit behind a rich, sweet, dark body. | 5.4 |  |
| 60 |  | Stanway Brewery | Stanway | Lords a Leaping | A dark full bodied beer with a strong crystal malt character. This Winter brew derives it name from the link with the Stanway House and the traditional Christmas song. | 4.5 |  |

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| 62 |  | Stroud Brewery | Stroud | Resolution | A strong tempting pale ale in the American style. Fresh fruit, grassy, and fragrant hops riding on a tasty soft and rounded blend of Maris Otter, Munich, and Cara Malts. Something to tempt even the strongest resolve. | 5.3 |  |
| 63 |  | Stroud Brewery | Stroud | Schwarzwälder | Organic cherry stout. A rich, sweet, stout porter conditioned on sour cherries and molasses. Dark roasted malts add a hint of chocolate, evoking a certain dessert from the Black Forest. | 5.0 |  |
| 64 |  | Swan Brewery | Leominster, Herefordshire | Mortimer Ale | Uniquely hopped, ruby ale specifically brewed for the anniversary of the Battle of Mortimer Cross 2nd Feb (1461 Wigmore, Herefordshire). | 4.5 |  |
| 65 |  | Swan Brewery | Leominster, Herefordshire | Neck Oil | A slick, triple-hopped copper coloured ale. | 3.4 |  |

| 67 |  | Teme Valley | Knightswick, Worcs. | Talbot Porter | Not been brewed since 2013 and a welcome return. A traditional Porter made with roasted Brown and Chocolate malts and hopped with UK Cascade from Herefordshire. | 4.4 |  |
| 68 |  | Tiley's | Ham | Tiley's Winter Warmer | | 4.8 |  |
| 69 |  | Tiny Rebel | Newport, Wales | Chocolate Stay Puft | They've smothered the biscuit and marshmallow foundation of Stay Puft with a glorious chocolate layer, like a liquid tea cake! It's even better than the original edition! | 5.2 |  |
| 70 |  | Tiny Rebel | Newport, Wales | Harry and Marv Winter IPA | It's light and spicy. Hints of orange with a very faint floral, grassy bitterness lingering throughout. | 4.5 |  |
| 71 |  | Tring Brewery | Tring, Herts. | Code Breaker | Plenty of oats deliver a clean, fresh and rounded body to this light-amber coloured ale. El Dorado hops give a flavour of stone-fruit and an aroma of pears. | 4.0 |  |
| 72 |  | Uley Brewery | Uley | Pigor Mortis | A strong, rich, dark ruby, winter ale with a smooth, malty, bitter taste followed by a fruity, port-like finish. | 6.0 |  |
| 73 |  | Unity Brewhouse | Suckley, Worcs | Phoenix Porter | Hints of chocolate malt combined with molasses and Phoenix hops create a bittersweet, dark ale. | 5.2 |  |
| 74 |  | Untapped | Raglan, Monmouths | Triple s | Three kinds of roasted malt produce a fabulously rich, dark colour. First Gold hops give a tang of zesty fruit, whilst Cascade hops give a sweetly nutty aroma | 4.9 |  |
| 75 |  | Velvet Owl Brewing Company | Quedgeley | Best Laid Plans | A blended beer of Imperial Red Ale infused with thyme and raspberries, and a whisky cask aged milk porter. An unusual combination, but it works! | 6.5 |  |
| 76 |  | Vibrant Forest | Lymington, Hants. | CambrDirect Root | This dark beer begins with smooth waves of chocolate and gently roasted coffee beans before a sudden and explosive burst of rich liquorice blasts all other sensation away. | 5.1 |  |
| 77 |  | Wadworth | Devizes, Wilts. | Old Timer | A respected elder of the beer world and an old favourite. Deep chestnut in colour with a strong malty aroma, and full bodied. | 5.8 |  |
